By electronically signing this form, you are agreeing to read or have read to you the information about your rights and responsibilities. You are also agreeing to follow all the DTA program requirements. These requirements can be found online at Mass.gov/DTARightsAndResponsibilities. DTA will also mail you a copy of these requirements.

They include your responsibility to:

- Provide DTA with true and complete information. If you do not, you may be subject to penalties, including disqualification from DTA programs, fines, and imprisonment.
- DTA verifies all information you provide and shares information with banks, schools, and government agencies to check your eligibility. This includes you and your household member's Social Security Number. DTA will check the immigration status of all noncitizen applicants through the U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services.
- DTA also shares information with utility companies, the Department of Revenue, the Department of Elementary and Secondary Education, the Department of Public Health, and the Department of Housing and Community Development to determine if you are eligible for any other benefits.
- Some DTA clients are subject to work requirements. If you are subject to work program requirements or express interest in a program, DTA may share your name and contact information with employment and training providers.
- If your DTA eligibility is due to a disability or a result of an accident or injury, special rules may apply to you.
- DTA cash benefits may not be used in certain locations (for example, liquor stores and casinos) and on certain items (for example, alcohol and cigarettes).
- If you have trouble reading or understanding any of the materials mailed to you, you may contact DTA for help. If you need an interpreter, DTA will provide one for you. If you need help because of a disability, you can also call the DTA Assistance Line at 877-382-2363.

By electronically signing this application, you are agreeing to all the terms and requirements of the program for which you are eligible. If you do not agree to any of the terms, you can call DTA or tell us in writing that you want to withdraw your application.
